Manners at a Restaurant

As soon as you are seated, $\qquad$ the napkin on the table, and put it in your lap.

Don't use the napkin to clean your face or hands. Start with the knife, fork, or spoon that is $\qquad$ from your plate. Eat to your left, drink to your right. Hold a knife in your right hand and fork in your left hand. After cutting food, eat food by $\qquad$ fork to right hand. Don't $\qquad$ your hands to catch something across the table. Don't talk with food in your mouth. Chew with your mouth $\qquad$ .

Don't blow on your food to $\qquad$ it off. Don't make loud eating noises and don't talk too loud. Don't blow your nose at the table. When you visit the restroom, say "Excuse me," or "'lll be right back." Turn off your cell phone or switch it to silent. Don't use a
